#### ORBIT

The system supplied by Redkite Systems, branded as ORBIT by London Heathrow, combines the features found in the Redkite PDS Course Management and PDS Tracker systems with some new in-built management functions empowering event organisers to plan, monitor and report training needs and outcomes ensuring the timely completion of training against time critical milestones for all stakeholders. Robust import and export processes facilitate the exchange of information between systems for international and multi-agency stakeholders to ensure all parties have up-to-the-minute information to harmonise their staff training with mission critical objectives. In addition to providing robust functionality, the highest levels of security have also been incorporated. As a web based solution hosted on the Redkite secure hosted server ORBIT has been rigorously tested using independent commercial penetration testing methodologies and has met the required standards.

#### Operational success

On xxxxxxxx 20xx ORBIT passed all acceptance tests and the system went 'live' on schedule. ORBIT was then used in accordance with requirements and, as planned, at around 05.49 am on June 4th 2014 the first passengers to be welcomed to T2 arrived on a Star Alliance United Airlines flight from Chicago On June 23rd 2014, T2 was officially opened and named "The Queens Terminal" by HM The Queen accompanied by HRH Duke of Edinburgh.

#### On-going

London Heathrow's T2, "The Queens Terminal" will become a central hub for Star Alliance airlines and, as part of a staggered programme, all Star Alliance airlines will relocate to T2. The Star Alliance members are Aegean Air, Air Canada, Air China, Air New Zealand, All Nippon Airways, Asiana Airlines, Austrian Airlines, Brussels Airlines, Croatia Airlines, EgyptAir, Ethiopian Airlines, EVA Air, LOT Polish Airlines, Lufthansa German Airlines, SAS Scandinavian Airlines, Singapore Airlines, South African Airways, Swiss International Airlines, TAP Air Portugal, Thai Airways International, Turkish Airlines, United Airlines, US Airways. In addition to the Star Alliance group T2 will also be used by airline operators Aer Lingus, Germanwings and Virgin Red.
