People undertake on-line knowledge assessments from any location at a time to suit them - or they can undertake on-line assessments in a more formal setting. A successful assessment can eliminate the need for costly refresher training.

Questions are created and stored in topic specific question banks. Any number of topics banks can be created.

Questions are in a multiple-choice format and there is no limit to the number of questions you can enter. Questions can have as many optional answers as are needed and users can be asked to select more than one correct option.

Questionnaires are delivered to candidates who will answer questions on a PC, tablet or via a web enabled smart phone. No software needs to be installed. Everything is delivered over the web.

For many staff this will mean that they can be assessed without the need for them to leave their workplace. Saving time and money.

Each question is generated at random and the optional answers are also presented in a random order.

Questions can be marked as they are answered showing both the correct and incorrect answers if required.

At the end of the assessment the candidate can be informed of the overall score and whether the assessment has been completed successfully.

The outcome of the assessment will be automatically passed to the candidate's personal portfolio where the results can be viewed in full detail providing substantiating evidence of knowledge and understanding in key competence areas.
